- Before you let your dog in the yard the next morning, please check for fireworks debris. Depending on wind conditions, that stuff can drift very easily. You don't want Fido munching on leftover sparklers!
- If your dog is frightened, put on some soothing music and turn it up. It won't mask the noise completely, but it can help.
